	Denominator Information	Numerator Information	Exclusions
Cervical Cancer Screening	Female members age 24 – 64.	Members with at least 1 claim for Pap test during the measurement year or the 2 years prior.	Female members age 24 – 64.
Colorectal Cancer Screening	All members age 51 – 80.	Members with one or more screenings for colorectal cancer. Appropriate screenings are defined by any one 1. Fecal occult blood test (FOBT) during the measurement year 2. Flexible sigmoidoscopy during the measurement year or the four years prior to the measurement year 3. Double contrast barium enema (DCBE) or air contrast barium enema during the measurement year or the four years prior to the measurement year 4. Colonoscopy during the measurement year or the nine years prior to the measurement year	Members may be excluded from this measure if they have colorectal cancer or have had a total Colectomy.
Breast Cancer Screening	Female members age 42 - 69.	Members with at least 1 claim for screening mammogram during the measurement year or the year prior.	Members may be excluded from this measure for any of the following reasons: a. Bilateral mastectomy b. Unilateral mastectomy (members must have 2 separate occurrences on 2 different dates of service)
