## **Craftsmen's Guild to get \$75,000**

The president of the UPMC Health Plan will award \$75,000 today to the Manchester Craftsmen's Guild, North Side, to support its jazz education and presentation programs.

Diane Holder will give a check to William E. Strickland Jr., president and CEO of Manchester Bidwell Corp., which runs the post-secondary school and the Bidwell Training Center.

The presentation is scheduled for 1 p.m. during a third-grade jazz concert of students from Allegheny Traditional Academy.

The UPMC gift will help the Guild in its concert presentations and serve as the lead gift for Manchester Bidwell's Annual Campaign, which kicked off in April. The gift also will aid in the restoration of the Guild's Third Grade Jazz Program, aimed at bringing the music to 3,500 third-grade students.
