North Side children will receive free vision screenings

Several agencies and the Children's Museum of Pittsburgh are joining forces to provide free vision screenings for children Monday at the museum, 10 Children's Way, North Side.

The screenings will be offered from 9 a.m. to noon for children in the Head Start preschool program and from 1 to 3 p.m. for all other children visiting the museum, as part of the second annual "See You, See Me" event, sponsored by UPMC Health Plan.

The screening takes from three to five minutes and tests children's visual acuity, color vision and eye muscle function. Children identified as having potential eye problems will be referred to eye-care professionals for further testing and follow-up care.
