## **UPMC touts revised ranking**

UPMC Health Plan said its ranking in an annual survey of America's Best Health Plans rose after the survey's results were restated. UPMC said the National Committee for Quality Assurance acknowledged that it committed an error in calculating the survey's results. UPMC Health's new ranking is No. 20, up from No. 35 in the results announced in October. Highmark's Keystone Health Plan West fell one place to No. 34, while HealthAmerica's ranking rose six spots to No. 38. Aetna of Pennsylvania fell one place to No. 71
